

# PROGRAMS

## Compassionate & Comprehensive Services



### Advocacy

Safety planning, assistance with protective orders and crime victims compensation, education on crime victims rights, law enforcement and court accompaniment, case management.



### A.D.V.A.N.C.E.

8-week psycho-educational class for victimized parents to learn how to parent through domestic violence and understand their rights.



### BIPP

(Battering Intervention & Prevention Program)

27-week psycho-educational group program to promote domestic violence offender accountability and promote safety for victims and their children.



### 24 HR Crisis Line

Support, crisis intervention, safety planning, information and referrals, screening for shelter entry, and intake scheduling. Telephone and text services available.



### Community Engagement

Outreach, awareness, prevention education and training for the community and criminal justice system.



### Counseling

Individual and group counseling for adults. Play therapy, activity therapy and group therapy for children and adolescents.



### Legal Department

Assistance with legal proceedings such as divorce, legal clinics, and high risk advocacy for victims with CPS involvement.



### Emergency Shelter

Residential services at two shelter locations, including advocacy, counseling, case management, and basic needs.



### Survivors Advocacy Team

On-call hospital and law enforcement accompaniment for victims.



### Transitional Housing

Assistance with securing safe housing options as victims exit shelter, flee abuse, or recover from financial abuse.



### Camp HOPE America-Texas, Denton County

A week-long, evidence based, trauma informed summer camp for youth exposed to domestic violence.



### Pathways

Year-round mentoring program for youth exposed to domestic violence, focused on STEAM activities.
